General Spots

Crystal Spotter®

Product Code: CS-4.1

Spray onto spot, agitate with Carpet Roamer Spotting tool and vacuum

Interim Cleaning

Crystal Dry® Extra

Product Code: CDX-2

Dilute 1 bottle Crystal Dry® Extra with 2 gallons of water, spray onto carpet, and agitate with a Smart Care® machine. Vacuum when dry or at next scheduled vacuum cycle.





Coffee, Tea, Wine

Crystal Red Stain® Plus

Product Code: CRS-5

Blot to remove as much liquid as possible. Apply Crystal Red Stain® Plus to clean dry cloth, and blot until there is no color transfer. Follow up with Crystal Spotter®.



Product Code: CEP-3

Add 1 bottle Crystal Extract® with 1 bottle
Crystal Dry® Extra to 2 gallons water,
spray onto carpet and agitate with Smart
Care® machine. Vacuum once dry or at
next scheduled vacuum cycle.





Organic Stains such as Urine, Vomit

Crystal® Odor & Protein

Product Code: COP-6.1

Remove any solids. Apply directly to spot; allow dwell time for product to remove stain and odor. Follow up with Crystal Spotter[®].

Stain Prevention

Crystal® Stain Block

Product Code: CSB-8

Add 1 bottle of Crystal® Stain Block with interim cleaning solution Crystal Dry Extra®.





Paint, Oil Grease, Tar

Crystal® Oil & Grease

Product Code: COG-7.1

Remover any solids, and/or excess liquids. Shake well, apply to clean cloth and blot until there is no color transfer. Follow up with Crystal Spotter®.



Crystal® Salt Remover

Product Code: CSR-10

Add 1 bottle to two gallons of water, agitate product into stained area and extract if needed.

Restorative Cleaning Organic Stains

Crystal[®] Quick Restore™

Product Code: CQR-11

Add 1 bottle of Crystal® Quick Restore™ to 2 gallons of water, spray onto carpet and agitate with a Smart Care® machine. Vacuum when dry or at next scheduled vacuum cycle. For heavily stained areas use double strength.
